An opportunity for you is coming up with the Marie Curie Individual Fellowship at the UB.

The Chair of Energy Sustainability was founded at 2012, led by the professor Maria Teresa Costa Campi and affiliated to the IEB, was created by an agreement between the University of Barcelona and the Foundation for Energy and Environmental Sustainability (FUNSEAM), whose members are the Repsol Foundation, Enagas, the ACS Foundation, CEPSA, CLH, Endesa, FCC Energia, Gas Natural Fenosa and EDP Renovaveis.

The Chair promotes research into the production, supply and use of the energy needed to maintain social welfare and development, placing special emphasis on economic, environmental and social aspects. Despite its short life, the Chair has shown a strong capacity of research output and growth, and it has obtained the governmental recognition as emergent group of excellence in research. ## **Description of the MSCA Fellowship Program:**

The purpose of the MSCA Individual Fellowship (IF) is to support the mobility of researchers and help attract promising foreign researchers to work in the European context (EU Member States and Associated Countries) or outside Europe. The grant typically covers two years' salary, a mobility allowance, research costs and overheads for the host institution. Individual researchers prepare and submit proposals for funding together with their planned supervisor/host organization. Proposals are judged on their research quality, impact and implementation, the researcher's future career prospects, and the support offered by the host organization.
